

GREETINGS:

February begins with a bang as Mars, the planet of action, squares off with the Sun in rebellious Aquarius. Welcome to a month of transformational intensity! The powerful combination of Jupiter and Saturn shining their light on one another together in Aquarius on the Winter Solstice (12/21/2020) opened a portal of growth and change which will accelerate this month. Here are the highlights:

MERCURY IS RETROGRADE UNTIL FEBRUARY 20:

As most of you know too well, when Mercury, the messenger of transportation, communication, and all things mechanical and electrical, takes a backward 3-week stance, things go haywire. This is a period where we should observe, plan, and wait to take action until after 2/20. On 2/20 Mercury moves back into forward motion so we can clear up what needs to be repaired during the three-week period of possible breakdowns in tech, as well as transportation and communication failures. Mercury will arrive at the point he went retrograde on March 13, so we have a few weeks to straighten things out.

VENUS, THE PLANET OF LOVE IS A STAR IN FEBRUARY:

Venus (Aphrodite) enters Aquarius on 2/1, intensifying our need for social connection with friends and family. We will be enriched through our relationships with like-minded people, especially those who share our goals and values. Venus joins Saturn on 2/6, asking us to take an honest look at the quality of our relationships, as well as being clear about our needs and whether they are being met. It is time to get a fresh start on our relationships, letting go of those that no longer serve our needs and support our future plans. Since Venus is occupying the sign of Aquarius which is ruled by Uranus and Uranus is occupying the sign of Taurus, which Venus rules, we are looking for change and freedom in our relationships. On 2/11 Venus joins Jupiter, just before the New Moon in Aquarius, expanding our deep feelings for those we love and depend on. THE DEFINING ASPECT OF 2021; SATURN SQUARES URANUS:
